Dear Parents,

Thank you for attending our Back to School Night presentations. We believe homework should be a link between home and school. It shares what we are learning in class and helps the students generalize and maintain skills. We look forward to a year of collaborating with you to promote your child's success. Students will receive homework Monday through Thursday each week, which will be noted on their weekly homework sheet in their folder as well as on the classroom website. Below, you will find the second grade homework policy.

Homework should take your child less than a half hour. If you notice your child having a difficult time completing his or her homework, please contact his or her teacher with a note or email. In the chart below are the assignments that will be given throughout the year. Remember to check your child's folder nightly for assignments and completed classwork.

<b>Reading</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read 10-20 minutes every night</li><li>• Return book bag <b>everyday!</b></li></ul>
<b>Word Study</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Daily dictation due Friday</li><li>• Occasional Worksheet due following day</li></ul>
<b>Math</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Math Facts (daily Fact Fluency practice due Friday)</li><li>• Occasional Worksheet due following day</li></ul>
<b>Current Events</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 Article and write up per month<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Please write neatly, in complete sentences.</li><li>○ See class schedule for your child's due date.</li><li>○ Please have your child practice reading their summary prior to their presentation date.</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>Reader's Response Journal</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 Reading Response entry per month<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Please have your child write neatly and in complete sentences.</li><li>○ The prompt for the month and an example will be provided in your child's journal.</li></ul></li></ul>

Students who receive homework passes may not use them on current events, reading responses, or nightly reading. More than five late homework assignments will be reflected on the report card. We appreciate your support in building this positive home-school relationship. We look forward to a great year!
